Indoor visiting starts Friday, Aug. 28

We know many of you are excited to come back inside the home for visits with your loved ones – thank you to everyone who's already reached out to book!

Here's what you need to know about indoor visiting:

- Visits will take place in the auditorium only – there will be no visitor travelling throughout the building or to resident floors/rooms.
- You need to bring proof of a negative COVID-19 test from the last two weeks.
- Visitors must wear a procedure/surgical mask and follow physical distancing for the duration of the visit (please bring your own mask – we have a small supply for those unable to bring one).
- All visits need to be booked in advance using the current booking system
- Indoor visits will take place on Monday, Wednesday and Friday – specific units will have dedicated days each week which we will share via email: Friday, Aug. 28 is unit 2, Monday, Aug. 31 is unit 3, Wednesday, Sept. 2 is unit 4 and Friday, Sept. 4 is unit 5.
 - Outdoor visits will continue Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday.
